Principal's Message

Your Elementary School has an exceptional staff that is dedicated to the highest standards of career and college preparation for all students with a focus on outcomes. Our team believes in providing a safe and productive environment for elementary school students. According to our latest Health Kids Survey, 87% of our students and 70% of our parents believe that our campus is safe.

Our team has aligned this report card with our School Site Improvement Plan and will work next year on two improvement goals: 1) Implementation of Peer Tutoring program targeting 5th and 6th grade students that are failing reading, writing, and/or mathematics, based on students' CST scores, report card, and teacher input; and 2) Implementation of a school-wide Bully Free program to promote positive school climate and student interaction. Individualized review of academic performance is integral to our student support services program. We are committed to the continuous improvement of our program and its alignment to the school's improvement plan.

Career and College Readiness Student Outcomes

Our staff believes that focusing on student outcomes is essential to preparation for Career and College. The area of 21st Century Skills includes the development of personal and social skills that will help our students' access career and college opportunities and keep them successfully engaged in life-long learning.

In addition to the student outcomes already listed, we are proud that:

- 99% of our sixth grade students are able to identify 3 areas of interest and 1 career interest
- 42% fewer students were referred to the office for disciplinary reasons
- 93% of students are able to identify good work habits
- our school gained 18 points in our API scores (896 from 878)
